A TENS machine if you are planning to use
one
Massage oils or lotions

# For the birth partner...

Water spray to cool and refresh mum
during labour
A change of clothes, toothbrush and
deodorant
Watch – to time contractions
Digital camera or camcorder (and
charger!)
Contact numbers list plus mobile phone,
or change for phone
Snacks and drinks
Things to pass the time: books, magazines,
music etc.

# For after your baby is born...

Going home outfit
Breastfeeding bras (if you are intending to
breastfeed)
Breast pads
Maternity pads/towels (at least 1 pack)
Nightdress or pyjamas
Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, shower
gel) – travel sized ones will take up less
room in your bag
An old dark coloured bath towel for your
first shower
Hairbrush
Toothbrush & toothpaste
Old or cheap knickers/disposable knickers
Ear plugs (in case you end up on a noisy
ward)
Arnica tablets (may help with bruising)

## For your baby...

Infant car seat – whether you are driving
home or going by taxi
A special 'going home' outfit
Sleepsuits (at least 2)
Bodysuits (at least 2)
Newborn hat
Scratchmitts
Nappies (at least 8)
Nappy sacks
Wipes and cotton wool
Muslin squares (a must for all new mums)
Snowsuit (for winter babies)
Baby blanket
